AzHHA Launches Newly Enhanced Online Job Service

Job seekers can also create a search agent to provide email notifications of jobs that match their criteria.

An added benefit for both employers and job seekers is access to the National Healthcare Career Network (NHCH), a group of over 185 top healthcare associations and professional organizations, including the American Hospital Association, the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Association of American Medical Colleges. AzHHA's alliance with the NHCN increases both the employer and job seekers' reach.
