Reporting Intelligence System for Emergencies (RISE)

RISE is a new HIE service designed to support the healthcare community with enhanced public health reporting during times of crisis. RISE supports ADHS by improving the timeliness, accuracy, and completeness of hospital reporting of key healthcare data needed during an emergency, such as a pandemic. The service is also designed to reduce hospital and health system burden related to state and federal reporting requirements by using the Arizona HIE as a data intermediary. The first phase of this new service will aim to automate the reporting of COVID-19 daily hospital reporting requirements. Future phases may expand this service for other reporting requirements.

Communicable Disease Surveillance & Reporting (CDSR)

CDSR is a new service designed to submit case reports from hospitals to ADHS by developing a standardized approach to use Health Current's statewide HIE as an intermediary between Arizona hospitals and ADHS. CDSR will support ADHS by improving the timeliness, accuracy, and completeness of communicable disease reporting, especially during emergencies such as a pandemic and will reduce hospital and health system burden related to state reporting requirements.
