



JOINAZ HEROES: FIGHT COVID-19!

We are looking for healthcare personnel, first responders, and other frontline and essential workers who have been diagnosed with COVID-19

AZ HEROES Participants will:

- Participate in weekly surveillance through short <u>surveys</u> and <u>at-home COVID-19 tests</u> for up to nine months
- Answer questions and complete <u>at-home</u>
 <u>COVID-19 tests</u> if they become ill during the study
- Complete surveys about their COVID-19 history, risks, and occupational exposure 3 times
- Go to Sonora Quest for a blood draw 3-4 times to test for <u>antibodies</u>

Participants will receive:

- Access to COVID-19 test results
- New information and updates on COVID-19
- Pride that comes with advancing the science of COVID-19

Are you eligible?

- Between 18 and 85 years old
- Work at least 30 hours a week in healthcare, as a first responder, frontline or essential worker
- Can speak English or Spanish

The purpose of CDC-funded AZ HEROES Study is to learn:

- How long the immune protection lasts after COVID-19 infection
- If re-infection happens and how it differs from the first infection
- The risk factors for COVID-19 in each group of workers

An Institutional Review Board responsible for human subjects research at The University of Arizona reviewed this research project and found it to be acceptable, according to state and federal regulations and University policies designed to protect the rights and welfare of participants in research.
